ATAL faculty development programme begins at IIT Bhubaneswar

BHUBANESWAR: AICTE Training and Learning (ATAL) faculty development programme on 'Personal Effectiveness' has been began at IIT Bhubaneswar. The initiative is making certain ability improvisation for all India council for technical training (AICTE) affiliated lecturers in these difficult occasions of the Covid-19 pandemic.

FDPs are free for all individuals. One participant can apply for optimum two FDPs. Number of individuals from host establishment must be lower than 30 per cent of the whole individuals of the programme.

ATAL academies have been established by AICTE to take care of these coaching programmes. Main goal of these academies is to plan and assist in imparting high quality technical training within the nation and to assist technical establishments in fostering analysis, innovation and entrepreneurship by means of coaching in numerous rising areas.

"Through our continuous learning programmes, IIT Bhubaneswar always leads the path in teaching and learning with a sustained effort to enhance the skills sets of teachers from all over the country. Around 200 faculty members from AICTE recognized Institutions from across the country are participating in the week-long event," stated Raja Kumar.
