Foremost goal of those academies is to plan and assist in imparting high quality technical schooling within the nation and to help technical establishments in fostering analysis, innovation and entrepreneurship via coaching in numerous rising areas.

Round 200 school members from AICTE acknowledged Establishments from throughout the nation are collaborating within the week-long occasion," stated Raja Kumar.
