

## ATAL faculty development programme begins at IIT Bhubaneswar

BHUBANESWAR: AICTE Training and Learning (ATAL) faculty development programme on 'Personal Effectiveness' has been began at IIT Bhubaneswar. The initiative is making certain talent improvisation for all India council for technical training (AICTE) affiliated academics in these difficult instances of the Covid-19 pandemic.

IIT Bhubaneswar is organising the primary ever ATAL faculty development programme (FDP) which presents steady studying alternatives to faculty members of AICTE accredited establishments from all around the nation. It will proceed until November 6.

This programme was inaugurated on Monday within the presence of Vinay Sahasrabudhe, chairman of Parliamentary Standing Committee on HRD, AICTE chairman Anil Sahasrabudhe and IIT Bhubaneswar director RV Raja Kumar.

Official sources mentioned faculty members of the AICTE accredited establishments, analysis students, postgraduate students, members from authorities, CBSE academics, trade (bureaucrats/technicians/members from trade) and employees of host establishments can participate within the programme.

FDPs are free for all members. One participant can apply for max two FDPs. Number of members from host establishment ought to be lower than 30 per cent of the whole members of the programme.

ATAL academies have been established by AICTE to take care of these coaching programmes. Main goal of these academies is to plan and assist in imparting high quality technical training within the nation and to help technical establishments in fostering analysis, innovation and entrepreneurship by way of coaching in varied rising areas.

"Through our continuous learning programmes, IIT Bhubaneswar always leads the path in teaching and learning with a sustained effort to enhance the skills sets of teachers from all over the country. Around 200 faculty members from AICTE recognized Institutions from across the country are participating in the week-long event," mentioned Raja Kumar.

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
