Blood donation camp held at IIT BBS

The IIT Bhubaneswar in association with the NSS Odisha organised a blood donation camp in collaboration with the Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar and NGO Sahaya at its campus on Sunday in the presence of IIT Bhubaneswar Director Prof RV Raja Kumar.

A total of 92 people including students, faculty and staff members donated blood. The samples were transported to the Blood bank of Capital Hospital.

Prof Raja Kumar hailed the
