Govt to rope in IITBBS to improve bus services

Bhubaneswar: The state government plans to engage Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhubaneswar, to conduct a study for improving Rajdhani bus services, launched by the Odisha state road transport corporation (OSRTC) in January this year. At present, 23 Rajdhani buses are connecting Bhubaneswar with 11 district headquarters towns.
