



IIT Bhubaneswar Completed Semester Examination in Pen and Paper Format – A mid of the Pandemic.

IIT Bhubaneswar completed the semester examination in pen and paper format – amidst epidemics.

**IIT Bhubaneswar adopts a unique approach in conducting online classes and semester exams.** In the midst of the Covid-19 epidemic, IIT Bhubaneswar has conducted semester exams for all UG, PG and PhD candidates except for the first year B.Tech in pen and paper format. Indian Institute of Technology, Bhubaneswar has completed its Spring and Semester examinations of 2020-21 by 15 March. After the lock-down announced in March 2020, the institute immediately changed its classes to online mode with prior planning, innovations and execution, a senior official said that “the institute has taken a very unique approach to conducting comprehensive pen and paper exams And developed the innovative online method, trained its faculty and successfully applied it to conduct the final semester examination in May 2020. “

IIT Bhubaneswar does not conduct semester exams for the first-year B.Tech course in all IITs across the country due to only late admissions and late commencement of the semester. Prof. Raja Kumar, Director, IIT Bhubaneswar stated that “Due to a very difficult epidemic, theory classes for the entire 2020-21 were also conducted online on time for all students. Laboratory training is important for science and engineering students and continuing during an epidemic is a serious problem.

He also stated that lab courses for students were conducted as both online and offline classrooms. Students were initially trained for experiments by live streaming or pre-recorded videos of experiments performed by faculty members on a laboratory table and then performed those experiments in a physical presence with hands-on experience. All students, except freshers, were brought to the campus, successfully conducting their full lab session during February – April 2021 with physical presence on campus.

But now, due to the second wave of Covid-19, the epidemic is in serious shape, with the physical presence of freshers, laboratory practice has been postponed, this exam will be conducted soon for B.Tech first year students with additional academic activities like yoga There may be classes. During the epidemic, be done online in a very new and unique way. In

addition, project and research seminars, evaluation of UG, PG and PhD programs were conducted on online platforms.

Prof. Raj Kumar stated that “IIT Bhubaneswar campus has been put through a very strict and enthusiastic implementation of awareness campaigns, except 5 cases in September 2021 and 7 cases in April 2021 and 5 cases in May 2021. . The participation of the entire community in that ”.
