Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has inaugurated two new academic complexes at the Indian Institute of Technology, Bhubaneswar today. The new academic complexes to be inaugurated are the Pushpagiri Lecture Hall Complex and the Rishikulya Hall of Residence.

According to reports, the official data issued states that the Government of India has sanctioned an amount of Rs. 1,260 Crore for the creation of the infrastructure at the institution in two phases.

Lecture hall amenities

IIT Bhubaneswar Director while speaking about the inauguration stated that the lecture halls are designed to be state of the art and also serve as e-classrooms where live streaming of lectures along with interaction can also be done along with lecture recording facility and can also be used for conventional classes.

The director further added that the lecture halls are designed to work with air conditioning as well as under natural ventilation during winters. The lecture halls will also have electrical connections for charging laptops, internet access through WiFi, document visualizers for board work along with whiteboards, CCTV cameras, etc.

He also pointed out that the flipped classroom complex can be used for conventional lectures, group tasks, individual work consisting of study, browsing, design, analysis, problem-solving, assignment, and interactions with teachers.

The Rushhikulya Hall of Residence at IIT Bhubaneswar will be a hostel for the students with all the modern amenities.
