

IIT Bhubaneswar to conduct online end semester exams for outgoing students



BHUBANESWAR :Keeping in thoughts the state of affairs arising out of the unfold of coronavirus and the lockdown, the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhubaneswar has determined to conduct end-semester exams for outgoing students by means of online mode. This will assist them in sticking to the educational calendar.

The resolution on this regard was taken by the IIT- Bhubaneswar's Senate "to uphold the principles of the institute and guarantee commencement of students with out compromising on the requirements of analysis". Students can select from two examination schedules, one ranging from June 24 and one other from the end of July or the primary week of August, as per their comfort, a press release from the IIT stated.

It additional stated that in case the pandemic state of affairs normalises by the end of July or the primary week of August, the students can come to the \underline{IIT} campus to seem for the second examination.

Earlier this month, in view of the <u>COVID-19 pandemic</u>, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) had additionally launched a notification for conducting remaining examinations of sophistication 10 (solely for the northeast district of Delhi) and sophistication 12 (All India) examinations which are scheduled to be held from July 1 to July 15.

CBSE had determined to conduct examinations on the respective colleges of the candidates as an alternative of the examination centre already allotted and added that it's going to additionally permit change of examination centre in respect of candidates who've shifted and are residing in another district within the nation than the place of their faculty.
