India is moving ahead to meet its target of sending a man to space by December 2021, announced ISRO chairman K Sivan on Saturday.

“By December 2021, the first Indian will be carried out, by own rocket, to space. This is our target, everybody at ISRO is working on that. ISRO’s ambitious Gaganyaan project aims to send a three-member crew to space for at least seven days”, the ISRO chief said.

IIT Director RV Raja Kumar presided over the function.

Members of Board of Governors, Deans, Heads of Schools, faculty, staff members and students of IIT Bhubaneswar were present on the occasion.

Degrees were conferred on 32 Ph.D, 105 M.Tech, 67 M.Sc and 152 B.Tech students.
