Welcome by Chairman and initial remarks of the members

The Chairman Prof. P. Rama Rao extended a hearty welcome to the members and introduced them. He apprised the members about the impending challenges and excitement that lies ahead of the BOG-members in providing guidance to IIT-BBS and nurturing it towards the path to become a world-class institute. The Chairman then invited initial remarks from the members.

Responding to the observations made by the Chairman, Mr. T. V. Mohandas Pai said that IIT-BBS should define its vision and mission clearly. He emphasized that in order to excel in the global domain IIT-BBS could designate a world-class institute as its role model and set its own aims, objectives, milestones for the next 10-years. He remarked that the institute should aim to be among the top-100 academic institutes in the world, be in the Shanghai list, and foster the mission "Earn Respect" from the global community. He felt that IIT-BBS should chart out the academic programs by keeping "Creativity & Innovation" at the forefront, and sustain the programs by "Empowering" the student and faculty with open-ended infrastructural and research support. He also proposed that IIT-BBS should inculcate the model of "Promise-and-Perform" at all levels. He also suggested signing of MoU with the Government like Navaratna Companies have. Mr. Mohandas Pai further added that in the new Governance Model for IITs, there should be a peer review of the targets set. Governance model should be robust and transparent with proper accountability. The institute has a role for the four important stakeholders, the Faculty, the Students, the Public, and the Government. He further reiterated the need to adopt A Unique Governance Model at IIT-BBS. He stressed the need to have a Vision-Workshop at the earliest.

Mr. S. K. Roongta, Chairman, SAIL put forth the suggestion to create a dynamic and performance oriented BOG in tune with corporate-style of functioning. He emphasized that IIT-BBS should actively engage "Industry-Participation" in its program, in order to infuse industry-specific domain knowledge to the students. One of his other suggestions was to involve the students in periodic "Brainstorming on Finance-Business-Industry". He said that the vision of the institute should have a clear strategy about not only producing good engineers but also good managers. Further he added that the Director should make decisions on all routine matters and the same should not be discussed in the Board. He stressed the need for adequate decentralization at all level and institute and industry association would be a key component in the vision document. Therefore, the institute should prepare a vision document of not more than 5 pages defining its role and strategy in clear cut terms.

On his opening remark Prof. S. K. Brahmachari, expressed his commitment to become a part of "IIT-BBS—The New Entity". He suggested that IIT-BBS should include in its aim the following statements: "Be Different", "Adapt the Best", "Let Other's Envy". Prof. Brahmachari also made emphatic suggestions to make the BOG a "Vision-Making Committee". Articulating on the theme he suggested that the board would like to discuss in depth the policies, vision, long term programs, and priorities. He further added that the Director of IIT should have the same power as DG, CSIR and make decisions on all routine matters and the same should not be brought to the Board. The Finance Committee and the Chairman of the Board should also take decisions wherever necessary. They can bring such agenda items to the Board only when it is deemed necessary. He also encouraged IIT-BBS to adopt video-conferencing. He said that the CSIR has already a number of time tested administrative manuals like purchase rules etc, which can be followed.

Prof. Brahmachari suggested that IIT-BBS should identify a theme for which it should be the specialized institute and known all over the world. The institute should provide excitement for learning. He also suggested that the following key concepts be included in the Vision Document: (1) Curriculum should not be overloaded, (2) Allow Diversity in Students' Growth, (3) Integrating Research Program with Natural and Human Resource of the Region.

Mr. S. Garg, Commissioner cum Secretary, Ministry of Industries, Govt. of Orissa appreciated the points made by the other members and added that IIT-BBS should be seen by the people of Orissa as a helping partner for its development. He also said that it is pertinent to have the School of Design & Creative Arts and the School of Marine and Climatology in IIT-BBS, as these Schools will be locally relevant to the State of Orissa. Considering the fact that Orissa has a 500 km of Coast Line, Marine studies should be an important component of the educational programme of the institute, he added. On the academic program, he briefly deliberated on the IIT and IIM models and suggested to (i) promote "communication-skill" development; (ii) encourage the students in taking "additional credits" beside the core-credits; (iii) introduce the concept of "team-credit" beside the existing "individual credit" earned by a student.

In his remarks, Prof. D. Acharya encouraged IIT-BBS to set a new trend with new visionary measures. He spoke about the role played by IIT, Kharagpur in mentoring the institute. He also stated that the Government should provide a broad management structure instead of micromanaging the institute.

The Chairman and all the members agreed to take up the immediate task of bringing out a "Vision Document of IIT-BBS". It was generally felt that the document should be highly objective, functional, be contained within about 5-pages and project a time line of next 10-years.

While summing up the initial responses by the members, the Chairman observed/commented on the following:

- 1. To make the Vision Document ensuring collective inputs, appropriate discussion and overall concurrence from all the members.
- 2. To adopt innovative methods in attracting bright students.
- 3. To imbibe IIT-BBS with the "Culture of Research" invoking the adage "Now is the Time".

The Chairman then invited Prof. M. Chakraborty to make a brief presentation on the present status of IIT-BBS.

Opening his presentation, Prof. Chakraborty thanked the Chair, as well as the members. He narrated the journey of IIT-BBS from Kharagpur to Bhubaneswar during 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 and thanked IIT-KGP, CSIR-IMMT, CTTC, and above all the Govt. of Orissa for all the help received. His presentation also included among others the following:

- (i) The Government of Orissa has provided 936 acres of land at Arugul (30 km from the city of Bhubaneswar) of which the Institute has already taken advanced possession of 517 acres and that the construction of 10 km boundary wall is in progress. He also informed that almost 4 km of boundary wall is completed, and that there is a delay.
- (ii) Creation of various schools at IIT-BBS in a borderless framework
- (iii) Proposal to introduce new academic program beside the existing B. Tech and Ph. D Some of the programs suggested are regular M. Tech., post-B.Sc. 4-year M. Tech., 2-year M.Sc. joint M.Sc.- Ph. D, joint M. Tech Ph. D and Masters Program for College teachers.
- (iv) Plans to create space and infrastructure to operate the various academic programs from the present location including hired facilities.
- (v) Steps taken up in awarding contract to Architect-cum-Project-Management-Consultant in building the new campus at Arugul
- (vi) The vision-statement of IIT-BBS to be recognized as individuals and as a community, and to nurture creation
- (vii) The future plans of developing the science-park.

The Chairman and the members actively participated in the discussion during/after the Director's presentation. The following comments/queries/points have been recorded:

(a) On academics, the Chairman briefly discussed the importance of the post-B.Sc. 4-year M. Tech programme. While discussing on collaborative efforts between University-R&D Lab, he shared his experiences quoting the examples of CLRI-Anna University, and ILS-Central University Hyderabad. He informed the Board that he has permitted the Director to visit the University of Warwick in May 2010 and discuss possible collaboration with the Group of Lord S. K. Bhattacharya in the area of Manufacturing. On the new campus, he narrated his experience at IISER-Mohali, and suggested that the IIT-BBS campus should be a Green Campus with adequate utilization of alternative energy resources. He also offered to help IIT-BBS in finding appropriate experts in guiding the Architect-cum-PMC team in achieving the above goals.

- (b) On academic programme, Mr. T. V. Mohandas Pai emphasized that IIT-BBS may consider establishing a School of Life Skills, and implement Philosophy in the UG-curriculum. He echoed the Chairman in making the new campus of IIT-BBS a Carbon-Neutral Campus. Towards this, he also invited IIT-BBS team to visit the Infosys Campus at Mysore and Bhubaneswar.
- (c) On the academic programme, especially on the creation of various Schools, Prof. Brahmachari requested IIT-BBS to have further brainstorming with an emphasis on "Integration of Science and Engineering towards Creation". He opined that, when viewed in a holistic framework, even traditional engineering disciplines hold the potential and promise to offer new directions in product creation. On establishing new institutes, he cited examples of NIPERs, emphasizing on tapping potential in a thoughtful manner. He suggested the future possibility of establishing a new research center of CSIR at Bhubaneswar. The Chairman welcomed Prof. Brahmachari to have such a center within or around the IIT-BBS Campus.

The Board after discussion decided to approve all the items including those approved by the Finance Committee. It was also decided that before the Board considers the Vision document in its next meeting, the same may be circulated by email among members

About the new campus, the Director explained to the BOG the entire process of issue of expression of interest and RFP regarding short listing of consultants for Design and Project Management Consultancy of the campus by a single firm. He added that out of three firms which finally submitted their technical and financial bids, the committee on EOI has shortlisted two firms viz, Canon Design International Pvt. Ltd. and CES (india) Pvt. Ltd. under QCBS System as H1 and H2 respectively. However, subsequent examination of the documents revealed that the H1 firm didn't fulfill all the prescribed criteria. Hence, it was proposed to consider the offer of H2 firm for award of work after negotiation and acceptance of other terms and conditions as given by the institute. This would be further subject to clearance by Audit.

Shri Ashok Thakur observed that all the premium for conversion of forest land including land acquisition has to be paid for by the State Government.
