Updated Information (16-11-2021)

1. Physical reporting of all Freshers 2021 is mandatory, with the below mentioned exception (Point -2). They will physically report to the institute with the consent of parents. Format for the parents' consent will be circulated for filling, signing and submitting.
2. **Students below the age of 18:**

Those having health or immunity related issues/concerns may apply to Dean, Academic (deanac@iitbbs.ac.in) for registration and attending the classes online without physical presence. However, such applications ([Download Form Here](#)) should be made by the students with the consent of their parents on or before 20th November, 2021. Students permitted by the Dean, Academic may attend online classes till further notice.

3. Students above the age of 18 who have not taken vaccines due to some valid reasons are allowed to report to the institute.
4. Vaccination for the unvaccinated/partially vaccinated students will be arranged by the institute to complete both the doses.
5. Classes will be held,
 - a. in Online mode, for all students during the quarantine period.
 - b. in Hybrid mode, on completion of the quarantine period. Offline classes will be held for the students in the campus and the Online mode of classes will continue to be held for students who are under 18 and permitted by the Dean, Academic to stay at their respective homes.
 - c. Same time table will be followed for both Offline and Online classes.
6. All students have to submit the consent for following the covid19 protocols certified by the parents. Format of the consent letter will be circulated.

Sub: Procedure for Reporting to the Campus by UG Freshers

Please note that reporting to the campus on the mentioned date (21st – 24th Nov'21) is compulsory (with the exemption mentioned at point-2, in the above). In case, due to health reasons, if the journey could not be performed, a prior approval of Dean Academics needs to be obtained.

1. It is expected that the students reaching campus must have taken at least one dose of vaccine. Institute will arrange to provide vaccination to unvaccinated students and also arrange for the second dose.

2. RT-PCR test negative report is mandatory for entering the campus, test taken within 72 hours before reporting to the campus, including the day of reaching (18th - 21st Nov).
3. All students reaching campus need to follow the institute SoP.
4. Students will have to undergo 10 days of quarantine, may be relaxed if situation permits, at the designated locations in the hostel.
5. During the quarantine period, moving around the hostel premises and meeting personally with other students/friends is strictly prohibited.
6. Food and other essential items will be provided at a point near the quarantine room.
7. If any student violates the above rules and regulations, he/she will be sent back to home or necessary action will be initiated.
8. Students once coming to the campus will not be allowed to visit outside except for medical reasons, as per SoP.
9. Parents will not be allowed to accompany the student inside the campus. Students will be received at the campus main gate and taken to the quarantine centre by the institute bus. A detailed step-by-step procedure will be shared by the hostel.
