

Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurates academic complex at IIT Bhubaneswar

The Government of India has sanctioned Rs 1,260 cr for the creation of infrastructure at IIT Bhubaneswar in two phases.

Bhubaneswar, Aug 20: Union Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated at least two academic complexes of international standard at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhubaneswar campus on Friday.

The new academic complexes which were inaugurated today are Pushpagiri Lecture Hall Complex and Rushikulya Hall of Residence.

Notably, the Government of India has sanctioned Rs 1,260 cr for the creation of infrastructure at IIT Bhubaneswar in two phases.

The Pushpagiri Lecture Hall Complex has been designed to be of new age with technologies like, e-classroom facility, lecture recording and live streaming, wi-fi ready, document visualizers for board apart from white board.

Similarly, the newly launched Rushikulya Hall of Residence is an international standard 800-single seated hostel with all the modern amenities.

Ahead of the inauguration of the new academic complexes the Director of IIT Bhubaneswar had informed that the new lecture hall complex has been named after the historical Pushpagiri University whereas the new hostel has been named after the famous river Rushikulya.
