

Battery vehicle service opens at IIT campus Friday, 28 June 2019 | PNS | BHUBANESWAR

Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bhubaneswar Director Prof RV Raja Kumar inaugurated a battery vehicle service at the institute's Argul campus here on Thursday with an aim to adopt green culture and promoting a greener ecosystem.
