# IITBBS opens help desk for JEE (Advanced) aspirants from state

**Institute Also Running Buses To Take Students To & From Campus**

**Bhubaneswar:** With the ministry of human resource development (MHRD) extending the last date of registration for JEE (Advanced) 2019 examination to May 14, the Indian Institute of Technology, Bhubaneswar (IITBBS) has opened a help desk for the aspirants from Odisha.

"Our aim is to ensure that all possible support from our end is extended to the the JEE aspirants from Odisha as per the directive of the Union ministry," RV Raja Ku-

mar, director of IITBBS, said. IIT Bhubaneswar set up the desk in the e-classroom at the laboratory complex on its permanent campus in Argul on May 9. As per the plan, payment can be made online from May 10 to May 15.

The IITBBS administrators said the facility will be

available to all the students from Odisha who have qualified for JEE (Advanced) Examination this year. The premier institute has also opened a special counter on its campus to help the students without internet facilities register for the test.

The institute director

said Cyclone Fani caused massive damages to infrastructure and vegetation, leaving people in the state without water, electricity, food and telecommunication.

"At this moment of crisis, we at IITBBS could restore all facilities including inter-

net services. Hence, we have established a special helpdesk to help the aspirants. We are also running a special bus service from the city to the campus for the aspirants," the director added.

An institute official told TOI that the special buses for the JEE (Advanced) aspirants will run between 9am and 2 pm from Patia Square and reach the IIT Bhubaneswar campus in Argul via Jaydev Vihar and Khandagiri. Meanwhile, the return buses will be available at 12 noon, 4 pm and 6 pm. Kumar further said IIT Bhubaneswar will stand by and extend all possible support to those in need in these difficult times.
