IIT Bhubaneswar has established a special help desk in the E-class room of the campus for facilitating online registration for JEE Advanced 2019. Check complete details here.

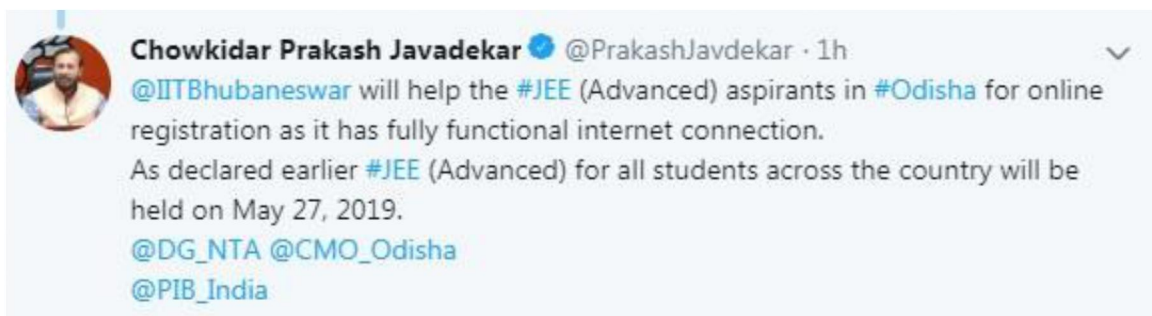

On May 7, the Union HRD Minister, Prakash Javadekar has directed the IIT, Bhubaneswar to help aspirants from Odisha in online registration for JEE Advanced Examination 2019 as the institute has fully functional internet connection.

The buses will start at 9:00 am and 2:00 pm from Patia Square and go via Jaydev Vihar-Khandagiri to IIT Bhubaneswar campus. The return buses from campus are available at 12 noon, 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm.
