SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF OPEN HOUSE ON JEE COUNSELLING

IIT Bhubaneswar successfully organized an Open House, JEE Counselling and Interaction meeting on 18 June 2019, for the benefit of IIT aspirants, in particular, those who qualified in JEE (Advanced) 2019 and for those who will be appearing in 2020. More than 150 students/parents actively participated in the counselling session.



The session started with welcome note by the Chairman, JEE Cell, IIT Bhubaneswar. Prof. R. V. Rajakumar, Director IIT Bhubaneswar welcomed the students and parents to IIT Bhubaneswar and congratulated the JEE (Adv.) qualified students for their commendable achievement. He gave an in-depth overview into the evolution of the IIT system in India including a brief talk on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd generation IITs, and IIT education in general.
