her. Called 'Know your police', the initiative will help students interact with police freely, ask them uncomfortable questions like whether they accept bribes and beat up people, and most importantly remove the fear of men in *khaki* from their minds.

Confirming the launch of the initiative, commissioner of police Satyajit Mohanty said, "We will announce the date of launch soon. We hope to introduce it within a week."

Sources said students between Classes VI and XI will be invited to police stations here where they will get a chance to see and understand how police work. Students in groups of 30 and 40 can visit the police stations on dates fixed by the commissionerate. "The initiative aims to help create a bond between the police and children and weed out the fear for *khaki*. It's often seen that children end up either hating or fearing the police because of their largely negative portrayal in films. Reports

of their corrupt practices in newspapers and television make matters worse. In such a scenario, children start seeing all policemen as corrupt and tainted," another police official said. "We want to tell the children that all police personnel are not rough and uncouth. Police stations also have a number of good officers," the official added.

As part of the initiative, students will be taken around the police station, shown the reception desk, *mahila* (women) and *sishu* (children) desk and *hazat* (lock-up). Students will also be familiarized with the penal provisions for different crimes and punishments apart, of course, from a station diary, FIR, charge-sheet, final report and court trial.

Police said the initiative will also

help the students understand better and make them "We often see students crimes to earn quick money. In interaction, we will see to their roles and responsibilities towards society and the the official said.

Students too welcome the initiative. "I have never visited a police station as I dread to know as to how a policeman or feels like in reality. I will visit one and observe," Aditi Das, a Class 10 student of SAI International School, said. Teachers said the convocation had been held in 2013-14 and should be held again this year.

Bhubaneswar: The Indian Institute of Technology, Bhubaneswar, will hold its 7th annual convocation on September 22 at its Argul campus near here. Ashutosh Sharma, secretary of the department of science and technology, is scheduled to attend the ceremony.

Official sources said 332 students will receive degrees on that day. Out of them, 162 are B.Tech students, 91 M.Tech, 69 MSc and 10 PhD students will be awarded with degrees.
