Professor Anil K. Gupta is a visiting faculty, Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad; after teaching there for four decades, and at IIT Bombay. Ph.D. (Management), MSc. Biochemical Genetics. Fellow: NAAS, WAAS, & INSA. Founder: The Honey Bee Network, National Innovation Foundation, www.<u>nifindia.org</u>, <u>SRISTI.org</u> and <u>GIAN.org</u>; CSIR Bhatnagar Fellow, 2018-21.

His mission is to expand the global as well as local space for innovations *from* and *for* grassroots, link ideas in informal and formal sector; to ensure recognition, respect and reward for creative communities, individuals, children and tech students etc., and to augment open innovations by individuals, institutions, corporations, and countries through frugal, flexible and friendly empathetic platforms. He is seen as a pioneer in the field of grassroots innovations, in which his contribution includes documenting people's knowledge with the help of teams of volunteers spread across India. He helps grassroots innovators and communities build on their knowledge systems by providing help in filing patents, promoting scientific validation of these innovations by involving government scientific institutes and private individuals and bodies and facilitating tieups with entrepreneurs and industrial groups.

For his contributions, Prof. Gupta was awarded the <u>Padma Shri</u> in the year 2004.
