ARINDAM CHAKRABARTI is an internationally-renowned scholar in Indian Philosophy, Aesthetics, Philosophy of Art, Buddhism, and Philosophy of Language. He is the author and editor of 17 books appearing in English, Sanskrit, and Bengali. He earned his BA from Presidency College in Calcutta, his MA from Calcutta University, and his D.Phil from Oxford. Since 1984, he has taught at University of Calcutta, University College London, University of Washington Seattle, University of Delhi and, for the last 25 years University of Hawaii. Recently, he has also held positions at Stony Brook University and Ashoka University. He has held visiting positions at the Institute of Advanced Studies in Edinburgh, the National Sanskrit University in Tirupati, at Trinity College Cambridge, and at the National Institute of Advanced Study, Bangalore. He published Denying Existence on the logic of singular negative existentials, from Synthese Library Series in 1997, and has most recently edited the Bloomsbury Research Handbook of Indian Aesthetics and Philosophy of Art (2016). His major book Realisms Interlinked: Objects, Subjects and Other Subjects was published from Bloomsbury in early 2019.
