A BRIEF REPORT



On the 18th of October 2022, the School of Humanities, Social Sciences & Management was fortunate to have participated in a dialogue with Dr. Niklas Swanstrom, Director, Europe-Asia Research Cooperation (YCAPS), and Dr. Jagannath P. Panda, Head, Stockholm Centre for South Asian and Indo-Pacific Affairs. The delegates arrived at 9:30, and in an intellectually stimulating discussion, they interacted with the faculty members and research scholars of SHSS&M. Following the introductions, a deliberation on the Russia-Ukraine War was presented by the delegates. The audience was encouraged to ask questions regarding the same, and an insightful debate ensued.
