Science Fair for Khudupur school students at School of Basic Sciences

The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) team organised a science fair was held in School of Basic Sciences on August 31, 2019 during 9: 00 am - 11:00 am for Class VI, VII, VIII students of Khudupur Upper Primary School. Around 30 kids accompanied with their Head Master participated in the event.

The event started with a warm-up session, that comprised of interaction with the students with some playful yet educational games on the whiteboard. This was followed by visit to the Science Fair Room, that housed 11 experiments in Physics and Chemistry disciplines. The exhibits included interesting demonstrations of parallel and series circuit connections using torch bulbs, ultrasonic sensor, dispersion of light using a prism, volcanic eruption, "Elephant's toothpaste" demonstration (involving decomposition of hydrogen peroxide), invisible ink, stress-strain properties of newspaper samples. The kids were mesmerised with the demonstrations and the UBA volunteers explained underlying science phenomena with ease and enthusiasm. After all the demonstrations were shown to the kids, light refreshment was served to the participants and a group photograph was taken.

The program ended with a high note with bright smiles on the faces of the young kids and heart-felt appreciation of their Head Master.
